Report World Quantum Day 18th April, 2025 (Friday)

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in collaboration with the Science & Technology Club and Faculty of Science & Technology (FST) celebrated World Quantum Day on 18th April, 2025 (Friday). Although the globally recognized date for World Quantum day is 14th April, 2025 we observed the celebration on 18th April, 2025 to accommodate academic schedules and ensure greater participation. The Theme for World Quantum Day 2025 is “Every Day in 2025”. A total of 47 students participated in the celebration, along with all faculty members of the FST department, marking full faculty presence and active involvement.
