## **Report Educational Visit to High Court of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla March 6, 2026 (Friday)**

The Faculty of Law, ICFAI University, Himachal Pradesh organized an educational visit to the High Court of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla on March 6, 2026, for the batches of 2025–2030, 2025–2028, 2024–2029, and 2024–2027. The purpose of the visit was to help students understand the functioning of courts, the duties of judicial officers, and the roles of judges, prosecutors, and defence lawyers in delivering justice.

45 students from ICFAI University, Himachal Pradesh visited the High Court of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla, on March 6, 2026. The students were accompanied by faculty members including Dr. Mamta Kumari, Dr. Champa, Dr. Legha Mamta, Mr. Vikram Kaushal, Mr. Vishav Kishore. The day started with a brief note given to the students about the Hon'ble Court and court rooms by Dr. Keshva Nand, Dean I/C, Faculty of Law. He guided all the students and explained the jurisdiction of the different Hon'ble Courts. The college bus left from the ICFAI University campus at 8:00 a.m. and reached the High Court of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla, at 12:30 p.m. The students visited different courtrooms and observed the Hon'ble Court proceedings. After observing the proceedings of the High Court of Himachal Pradesh, all the students proceeded towards Mall Road, Shimla at 1:30 p.m., where they had their lunch. At 2:30 p.m., the students were directed to gather again at the High Court.

The students were given the opportunity to interact with Hon'ble Judges and eminent advocates, who enlightened them about various aspects of the judicial system. They explained the differences in proceedings between the District Court, High Court, and the Supreme Court of India. They also discussed the differences in jurisdiction among the District Court, High Court, and Supreme Court. At 4:00 p.m., the students proceeded to the college bus located on Shimla Bypass. All the students boarded the college bus at 4:30 p.m. and started their return journey back to ICFAI University, Baddi. They reached the university campus at 8:30 p.m., and with this, the visit concluded successfully.
