

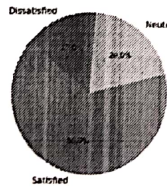
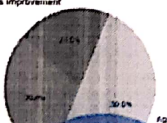
Report On Student Feedback Forms (2024)

- 5 - Strongly Agree

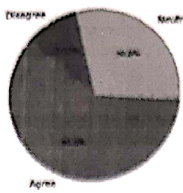
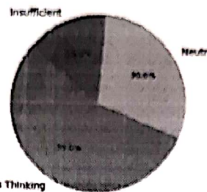
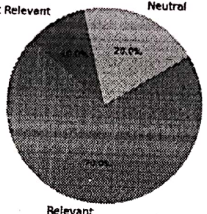
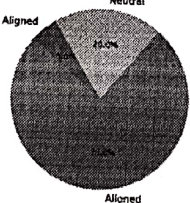
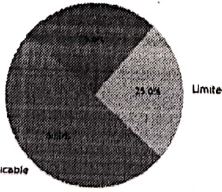
The responses reflect students' perceptions of institutional performance, helping in strategic decision-making and future enhancements.

2	Does the syllabus cover advanced topics?	<p>Coverage of Advanced Topics</p> 	30% strongly agree, 50% agree, 20% feel improvements are needed.



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3	Does the syllabus enhance your knowledge and skills in the relevant domain?	Enhancement of Knowledge and Skills 	60% agree, while 10% disagree.
4	Is the syllabus effective in developing critical/analytical thinking?	Development of Critical Thinking 	55% agree, 15% find it insufficient.
5	Are the textbooks and reference materials relevant to the syllabus content?	Relevance of Textbooks and Materials 	70% find materials relevant, but 10% disagree.
6	Does the syllabus orient towards higher education?	Syllabus Orientation Towards Higher Education 	75% agree, while 5% remain neutral.
7	Does the syllabus enable students to apply their knowledge in real-life situations?	Real-life Application of Knowledge 	50% agree, 25% believe practical application is limited.
